



# I-17/SR 179 TI Southbound Bridge Rehabilitation

## OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation has initiated a southbound I-17 bridge rehabilitation project at the I-17/SR 179 traffic interchange approximately 15 miles east of Sedona (MP 299).

## PROJECT ELEMENTS

The purpose of this project is to extend the functional life of the bridge.

Project elements include:

- ▶ Remove and replace top layer of pavement on the southbound bridge deck
- ▶ Repair concrete, as needed
- ▶ Construct new approach slabs
- ▶ Install new expansion joints
- ▶ Repair slope paving
- ▶ Replace guardrail and embankment curb, as needed

## PROJECT SCHEDULE

Construction is scheduled to begin late spring 2026 with completion anticipated for winter 2026.

## WHAT TO EXPECT

Southbound I-17 will be narrowed to one lane 24/7 through the construction zone for the duration of the project.

A mandatory brake check will be in effect for all semi-trucks at the southbound overlook approximately 13 miles north of the I-17/SR 179 interchange.

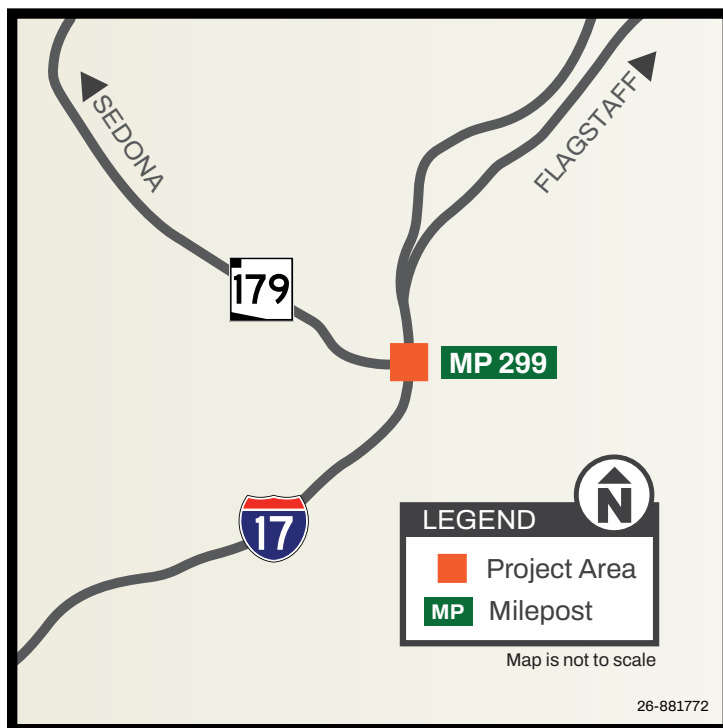
ADOT advises drivers to plan for delays while the work is underway.
