REHABILITATION PROJECT

PROJECT OVERVIEW

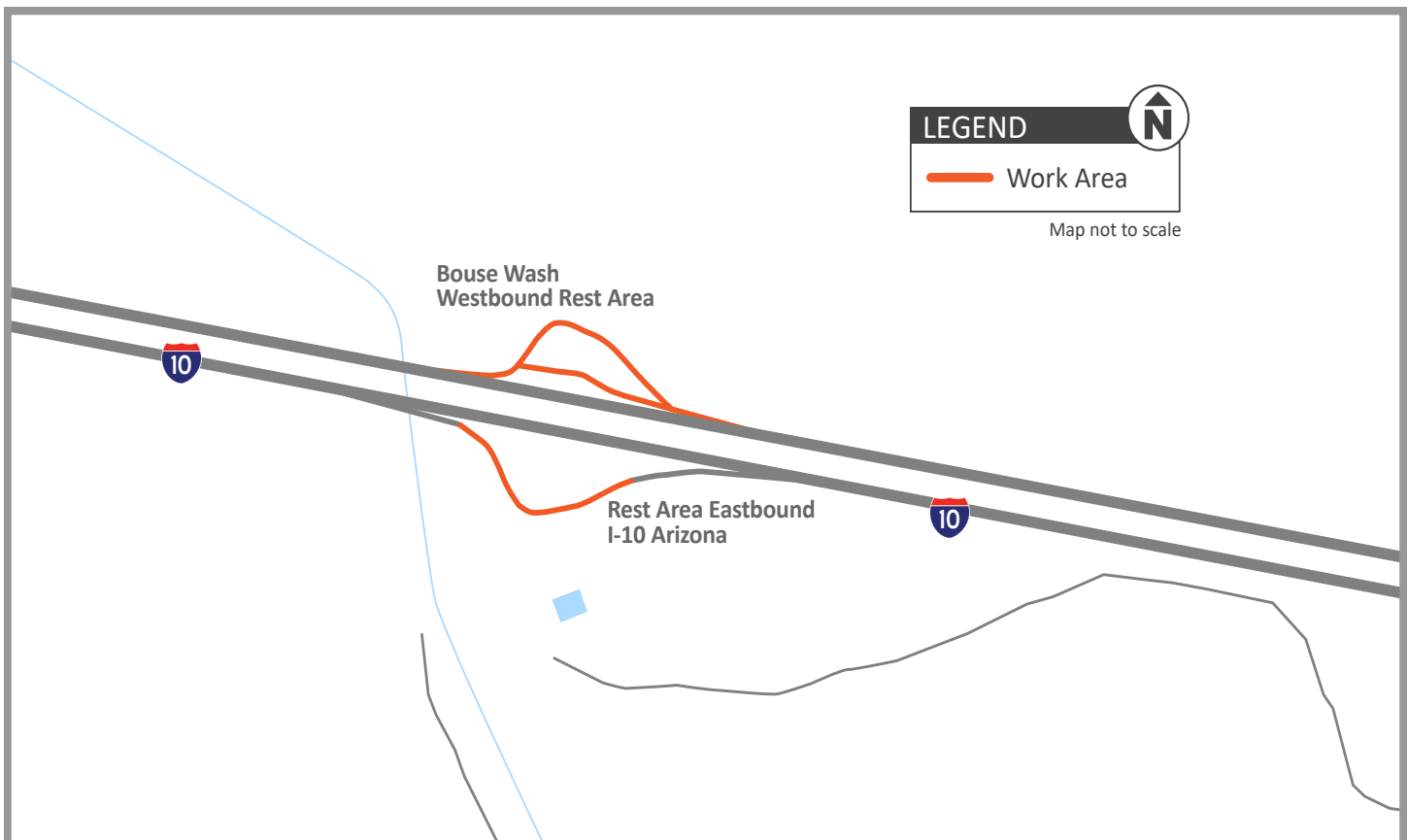
The Arizona Department of Transportation is rehabilitating the Interstate 10 Bouse Wash Rest Area at milepost 53. The work consists of rehabilitation of the east- and westbound rest areas to include upgrading equipment in the rest rooms, renovations to the vending building and ramadas, as well as parking lot improvements. The work also includes providing pavement markings and signage, improving the flooring in the residence building, implementing Americans with Disabilities Act compliance upgrades, rehabilitation of the existing water and wastewater systems, and other related work items.

WHAT TO EXPECT

The project is scheduled to begin early spring 2020. Drivers should plan for closures during rehabilitation. Travelers may continue to use the Burnt Well Rest Area along I-10 at milepost 86 or the Ehrenberg Rest Area near the Arizona/California state line while the Bouse Wash Rest Area is closed.
