


Design-Build Delivery Method

Schedule




- Begin Design and Construction: April 2020

- Construction Completion Goal: Fall 2021




Major Project Elements

- Widen SR 189 for a new raised median
- New 2-lane roundabout intersection at Target Range Rd
- New traffic signal at Loma Mariposa Rd
- New flyover ramps connecting SR 189 with I-19
- Add a 3rd lane on SR 189:
 - Westbound from Grand Ave to La Quinta Rd
 - Eastbound from Loma Mariposa Rd to Congress Dr
- Improvements on Grand Ave
