

LOOP 101 PIMA FREEWAY

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Pima Freeway ramps closed at 64th Street and Scottsdale Road June 14 through late August 2020

Beginning at **9 p.m. Sunday, June 14** the westbound Pima Freeway off-ramp at 64th Street and the westbound on-ramp at Scottsdale Road will be closed through mid-August.

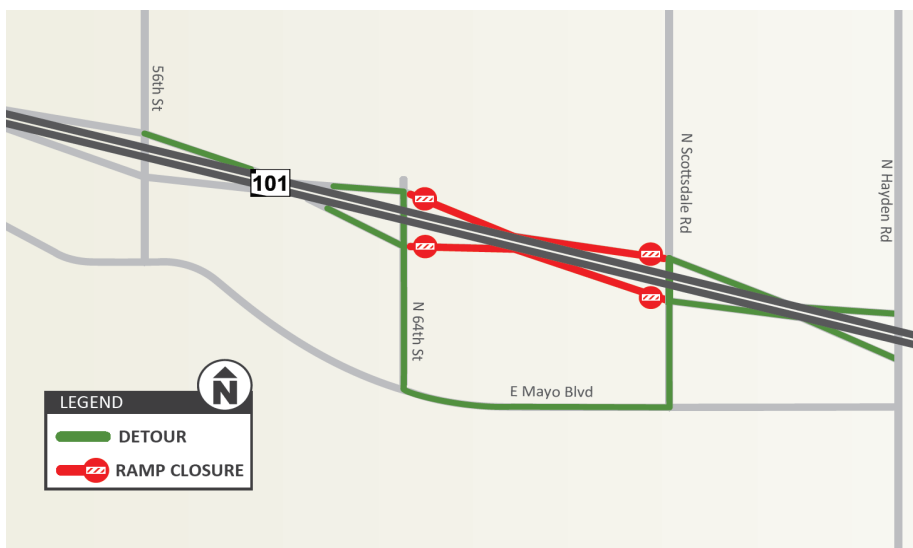
- **DETOURS:** Drivers can access 64th Street by exiting at Scottsdale Road and using westbound Mayo Boulevard to 64th Street. Drivers can use westbound Mayo Boulevard to northbound 64th Street to enter the westbound Pima Freeway.

Beginning at **9 p.m. Sunday, June 21**, the eastbound Pima Freeway on-ramp at 64th Street and the eastbound off-ramp at Scottsdale Road will be closed through late August.

- **DETOURS:** Drivers can use eastbound Mayo Boulevard to northbound Scottsdale Road to enter the eastbound Pima Freeway. Drivers can access Scottsdale Road by exiting at 64th Street and using Mayo Boulevard to Scottsdale Road.

ALTERNATE DETOURS: Drivers can use Hayden Road and 56th Street as alternate routes.

The closures are needed to reconstruct the ramps to accommodate the new travel lanes on the freeway.
