WHAT TO EXPECT:


- Time frame Approx. September 2020 February 2021
- This lane configuration will be set up 24 hours a day

Traffic Configuration:

- Continuous shoulder and outside lane closures with or without temporary concrete barrier (very common):
- Factors to Consider:
 - In two lane two-way sections, this could restrict a vehicle's ability to pull off the roadway in an emergency.
 - May require emergency responders to travel in opposing traffic lane or middle turning lane if traffic is backed up.
 - Use caution if shoulder is closed with only vertical panels, as there could still be construction activity or uneven terrain within the shoulder area and beyond.
 - Both shoulders will be closed at the same time.


