

# Commercial Purpose Worksheet

Persons requesting public records for a **commercial purpose** must provide a statement setting forth the commercial purpose for which the records will be used. A.R.S. § 39-121.03(A).

A **commercial purpose** is defined by A.R.S § 39-121.03(D) as the use of a public record for the purpose of:

- *The sale or resale or for the purpose of producing a document containing all or part of the copy, printout or photograph for sale or*
- *Obtaining the names and addresses from public records for the purpose of solicitation or*
- *The sale of names and addresses to another for the purpose of solicitation or*
- *For any purpose in which the purchaser can reasonably anticipate the receipt of monetary gain from the direct or indirect use of the public record.*
