ADOT'S NONDISCRIMINATION NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) hereby gives public notice that it is the Agency's policy to assure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA), and other related authorities in all of its programs and activities.

ADOT's Title VI and ADA Programs require that no person shall, on the grounds of race, color, national origin, or disability, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity.

Any person, who believes his/her Title VI or ADA rights have been violated, may file a complaint. Any such complaint must be in writing and filed with the ADOT Civil Rights Office within one hundred eighty (180) days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence. 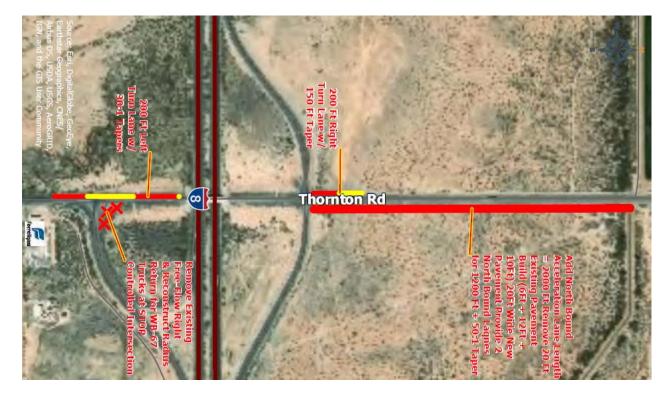

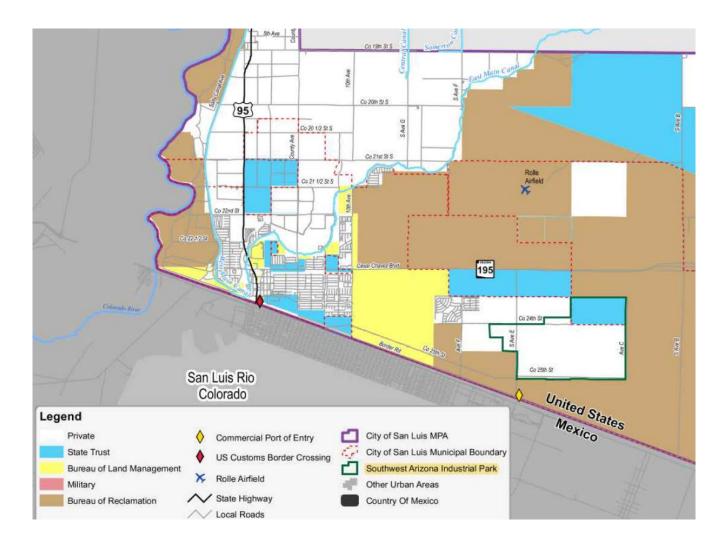

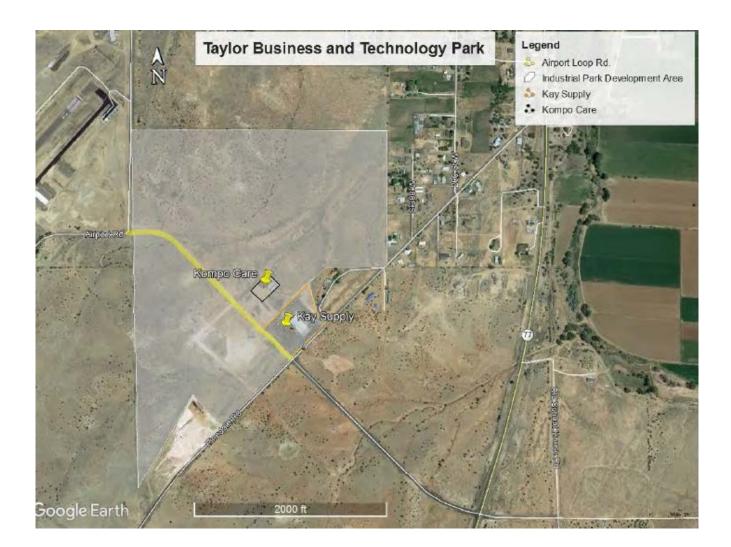

26. JUSTIFICATION OF REQUEST

The scoping outreach process, specifically with MAG and the Gila River Indian Community, resulted in adding interchanges at Wild Horse Pass and SR 347 to this current scope of work. Initially, they were being studied under a separate MAG planning study but after coordination they were added to this study as this effort is conducting formal NEPA. Additional funds are also being requested to cover the virtual public meeting format to present the current alternatives to agencies and the public.

AFIS's available budget was initially used for calculating the funding shortfall; however, AFIS does not subtract ICAP and it showed a number higher than what was truly available for consultant costs. This request addresses the funding gap.

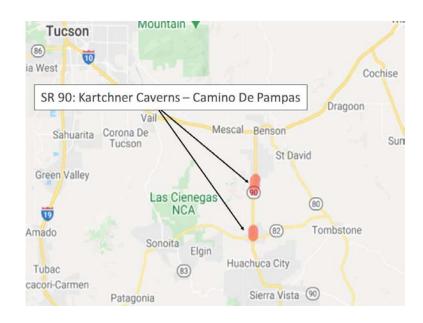
