



State Route 24 Interim Phase II: Ellsworth Road to Ironwood Drive Construction Notice

IRONWOOD DRIVE CLOSURES AND RESTRICTIONS TO BEGIN JAN. 18

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Beginning Jan. 18 through July 2021, Ironwood Drive north of Germann Road will be restricted to one lane in each direction while crews begin widening the road in preparation for the future State Route 24. The work will be done in phases.

- Phase 1 (through January): North- and southbound Ironwood Drive will be restricted to the outside lanes while crews complete the required median work.
- Phase 2 (February through April): Southbound Ironwood Drive will be closed. All traffic will be shifted to the northbound lanes.
- Phase 3 (April through July): Northbound Ironwood Drive will be closed. All traffic will be shifted to the southbound lanes.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

- Phase II of SR 24 includes approximately five miles of new freeway extending from Ellsworth Road to Ironwood Drive.
- The new roadway includes two lanes in each direction separated by a median; at-grade intersections at Williams Field Road, Signal Butte Road, Meridian Road and Ironwood Drive; and bridges over Ellsworth and Mountain roads. Project construction has begun and is expected to be complete in late 2022.
