NW Light Rail Extension Awarded \$50M+ in Grants

Valley Metro's Northwest Phase II Light Rail Extension project has been awarded \$49.4M in Capital Investment Grants and a \$1M planning grant by the Federal Transit Administration.

The 1.6-mile project will extend light rail to **Metrocenter Mall** from its current site at 19th and West Dunlap avenues. Construction is targeted for completion in November of 2024. Sewer and other utility relocation work is already underway.

Earlier in December, FTA announced it intends to award Valley Metro's **South Central Extension/Downtown Hub** projects a grant of \$530M. (<u>Source</u>)

Construction Has Highest COVID Positivity Rates

A study administered by testing firm **Curative** showed construction workers have the highest **COVID-19** positivity rates for asymptomatic cases across all occupations. In examining the results of more than 730,000 tests, the study found construction workers showed a positivity rate of 5.7 percent for individuals without symptoms. Food service workers were next at 3.8 percent. For cases with symptoms, construction workers were 10.1 percent, second only to corrections staff at 12.5 percent. Several other recent studies have also shown construction workers to be among the leading demographics for positive coronavirus tests. (Source)



Florence to See Bridge, Roundabout in 2022

2022 could see two major transportation projects coming to Florence. The first will be replacing the **Gila River Bridge** on SR 79. Florence has been working with consultants and the **Arizona Department of Transportation** for two years on plans for the project. Construction was originally planned for 2020, then 2023, and now the target is 2022. To minimize closures and traffic impacts, the bridge will be constructed off-site and slid into place.

Also planned for 2022 is construction of the town's first roundabout at the intersection of state routes 79B and 287. Design work is planned for completion this year, with construction commencing in 2022. (<u>Source</u>)

Enrollment Open for Habitat's Spring CIT Program

The **Habitat for Humanity Construction in Training** pre-apprenticeship program is a 16-week, fast track, on the job training program. The program is uniquely designed as an immersive and intensive curriculum that specializes in basic core construction fundamentals, leadership and soft skills development for participants ages 18 and over that are disenfranchised, underserved, underemployed and at-risk of being left out of the economy.

The specialized training curriculum integrates technical, behavior and mindset skills where on the job failure is most likely to occur. Most of the job technical training curriculum emphasizes on practical skills. Assessment is done on a regular basis throughout the program focusing on attendance, literacy, and construction math gains for each participant through an individual development plan. Keeping with Habitat's vision, mission and values, our focused CIT candidates will work together with sponsors to build a new affordable home for their community and have other hands on opportunities through our Aging in Place, Neighborhood Revitalization, and Emergency Service departments. This OJT will strengthen the CIT trainees job placement transition opportunities with all state and national construction apprenticeship programs.
