




PROJECT DEVELOPMENT Project Set Up – Funding Authorization


Change Approval Process

HOW ARE PROJECT CHANGES APPROVED AND DOCUMENTED?

- Changes in project scope, schedule, or budget require formal approval from ADOT boards/committees
 - 3 tiered process
 - Project review board (PRB) meets every Tuesday at 9:00 am
 - Priority planning advisory committee (PPAC) meets once a month
 - State Transportation board meets once a month




