Revised as of April 1, 2015





Main Objectives:

- Ensure non-discrimination in the award and administration of federally funded contracts
- Create a level playing field on which DBEs can compete fairly for federally funded contracts

AZ UTRACS Registration

Start AZ UTRACS Registration

AZ UTRACS Registration is a business registration required for all firms who wish to work on federally funded transportation projects in Arizona, including Prime Contractors and Prime Consultants, Subcontractors, Subconsultants, Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBEs), and Small Business Concerns (SBCs).

This registration satisfies a federal requirement (49 CFR Part 26.11(c)) that instructs ADOT to maintain a bidder's list to help the agency calculate its overall triennial DBE for FHWA, FTA and FAA funded contracts, as well calculate individual contract goals for FHWA funded contracts.

A benefit associated with completing this registration is that your firm is added to the AZ UTRACS Transportation Business Directory and a comprehensive firm profile is created, at no cost to your firm. This is used to advertise your firm's capabilities to the business community. This allows firms to find one another and partner to complete Arizona Transportation projects. The firm directory, where firm profiles are accessed, also helps firms find DBEs and SBCs needed to meet specific contract requirements.

AZ UTRACS Registration

Primes and subs, including DBEs, must be registered in the Arizona Unified Transportation Registration and Certification System (AZ UTRACS) web portal



DBE & OJT Online Reporting System DOORS Contract Management

All federal contracts are managed for DBE & OJT compliance

- Report payments (primes, primes to all subs)
 - Monitor for prompt payment compliance
 - Track utilization

Payment Reporting

Prime reports payments (including \$0) in the ADOT DOORS for all subs, by 15th of every month

Subs must confirm payments no later than 45 days



Payment Reporting Monitoring

ADOT groups monitor for compliance in DOORS





Termination/Substitution/Reduction of Work (TSR)

- Applies to all DBEs listed on DBE Affidavit
- Prime must contact PM/RE/BECO within 24 hours
- Prime must notify the DBE
- TSR Request Form must be submitted to ADOT
- Good Faith Effort (GFE), if applicable

BECO approves all DBE Termination/Substitution/ Reduction of work requests

Remedies available for non-compliance



Commercially Useful Function (CUF)

- DBE credit applied only when it is determined that the DBE is performing a CUF
- Only work performed by the DBE counts toward DBE participation
- Work subcontracted to non-DBE firms does not count towards DBE participation (except trucking services)

- BECO conducts all CUF reviews
 - Construction
 - Planning
 - Engineering/Design

Certification of Final DBE Payment (COP)

- Certifies the amount paid to DBE counts towards DBE participation
- Received from prime no later than 30 days after the DBE completes work
- Required for contract closeout



Certification of DBE Final Payment (COP)

A completed and signed COP for each DBE on the project must be submitted by the contractor no later than 30 days after final payment to DBE

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

ADOT OJT Program

Main Objectives:

- To offer equal opportunity for the training and upgrading of minorities, women, and disadvantaged persons toward journeyman status in the highway construction trades
- To improve the skills of the available workforce for Arizona's Federally-funded highway construction projects



ADOT OJT Program

- Applicable to all ADOT FHWA funded construction projects
- All FHWA projects must be assessed for an OJT goal
- ADOT Annual OJT Goal:

2020 - 37,000 OJT Hours and 64 Trainees





OJT Compliance Requirements

- BECO and Field Office monitor OJT compliance at the project level
- Electronic Compliance Submittals in ADOT DOORS OJT Module
 - Field Office reimburses eligible OJT hours (\$3/Hour)
 - BECO reports OJT participation to FHWA annually
