



State Route 89 at Road 1 North, Chino Valley

TRAFFIC SIGNAL INSTALLATION AND ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation, in conjunction with the Federal Highway Administration and the town of Chino Valley, is planning to improve a section of State Route 89 in Chino Valley. The project will occur on SR 89 at Road 1 North (mileposts 327 to 328) and will include installing a new traffic signal and traffic detection sensors at the SR 89 and Road 1 North intersection. In addition, ADOT will install a right-turn lane on northbound SR 89 to east Road 1 North, and construct left-turn lanes and widen SR 89 at Road 1 North.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Construction is scheduled to begin July 2021. Drivers should plan for periodic short-term lane closures for signal installation, roadway paving and striping during daytime operations 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Mondays through Thursdays. During construction, ADOT's contractor will maintain two lanes of traffic on north- and southbound SR 89 and one lane on Road 1 North. Flaggers may be on site to assist with traffic control. No weekend or holiday work will be scheduled.
