

State Route 89 – Paulden to Hell Canyon Bridge

PAVEMENT REPAIR PROJECT

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation is initiating a project to repair and preserve the pavement along State Route 89 from Pittsburgh Road, in Paulden (milepost 338) to Hell Canyon Bridge (milepost 344). The project includes the following:

- Applying micro-surfacing and rut filling treatments to the pavement surface on north- and southbound lanes.
- Adding roadway striping and new pavement markings.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Construction is scheduled to begin summer of 2021 and continue through the fall of 2021. During construction, motorists will encounter alternating lane closures with one lane of traffic maintained throughout construction. Flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control. No weekend or holiday work will be scheduled.
