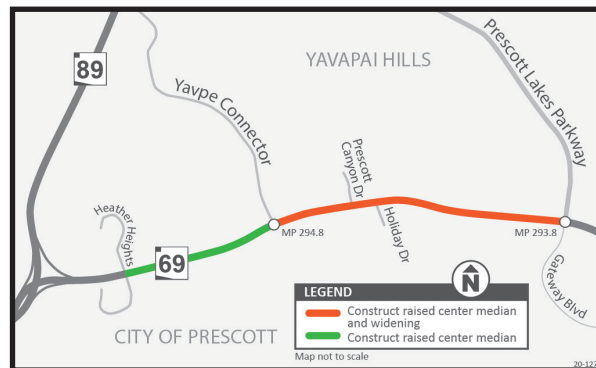




YOU'RE INVITED! State Route 69 Virtual Public Meetings

PRESCOTT LAKES PARKWAY TO FRONTIER VILLAGE WIDENING PROJECT

The Arizona Department of Transportation, in partnership with the Central Yavapai Metropolitan Planning Organization, is planning to widen State Route 69 in the city of Prescott. The project will add one new travel lane in each direction with a raised center median on SR 69 between Prescott Lakes Parkway and Yavpe Connector. A new raised center median will also be constructed from Yavpe Connector to Heather Heights. The purpose of this project is to improve traffic safety and operations. Information on the project is available on the project website, and public comments will be accepted between May 12 and June 12, 2021.
