



Interstate 17: Verde River Bridges

BRIDGE REHABILITATION AND REPLACEMENT PROJECT

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation, in conjunction with the Federal Highway Administration, is planning to improve the life of the Verde River Bridges by installing erosion-control measures and rehabilitating the structural integrity. New reinforced concrete aprons will be installed around each pier of both seven-span bridges to protect the structure from erosion. The project, on Interstate 17 between mileposts 287 and 289, is approximately one mile north of the junction with State Route 260 in Camp Verde. The project will occur within ADOT right-of-way and easements underneath the bridge.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Construction is anticipated to begin Sept. 2021 and be completed spring 2022. There are no anticipated restrictions for drivers on I-17.

During construction, river users will be required to portage around the construction site.
