

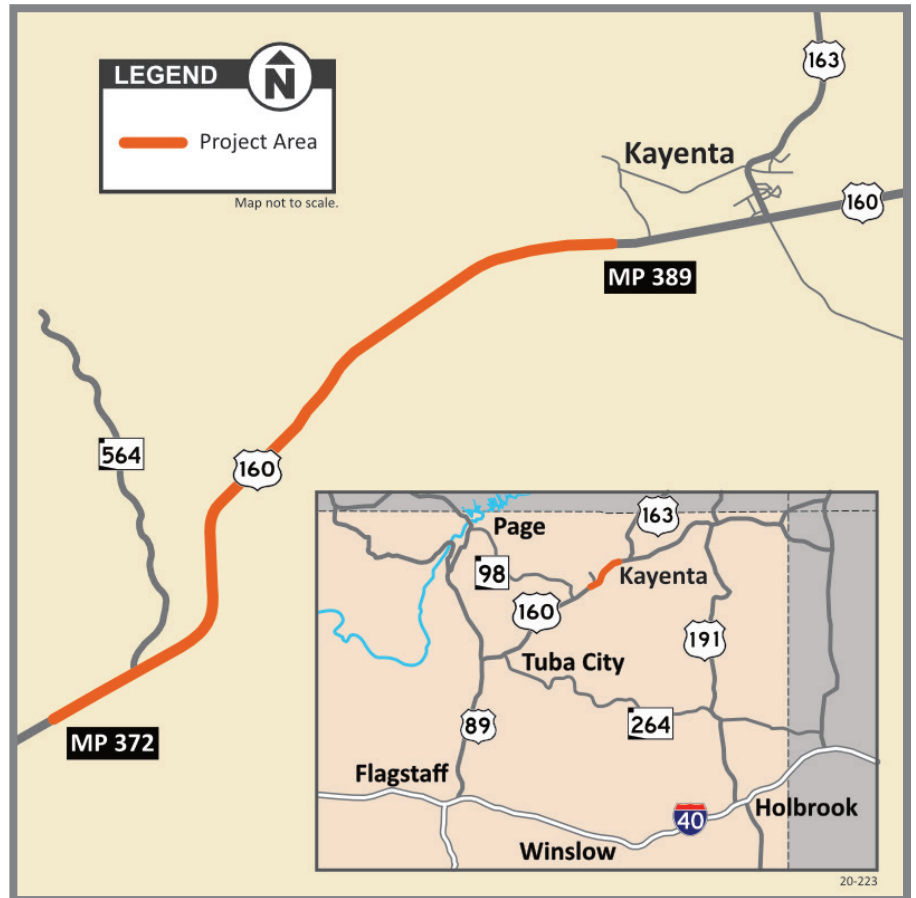


US 160: Long House Valley-Kayenta

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation has initiated a pavement rehabilitation project on US 160 between US 160 between Long House Valley and Kayenta. The project is located between mileposts 372 and 389 on the Navajo Nation. The purpose of the project is to rehabilitate the pavement, upgrade guardrails and signage to current ADOT standards and improve the safety of the highway. The scope of the project includes:

- Removing and replacing pavement along the full length of the project.
- Repaving general turnouts and bus pullouts.
- Paving unpaved general turnouts and unpaved bus pullouts.
- Improving drainage on sections of the highway.
- Reconstructing embankment curbs and building up shoulders.
- Removing and replacing guardrails and end treatments.
- Modifying cattle guards.
- Rockfall mitigation and rock scaling at MP 383.
- Installing centerline and shoulder rumble strips.
- Other related work.



WHAT TO EXPECT

Construction is anticipated to begin in fall 2021 and continue over two construction seasons. Construction will shut down for the winter as pavement work cannot be performed during the winter months due to low temperatures and wet weather conditions.

During construction, temporary lane restrictions are anticipated for crews to safely work on the roadway. Full road closures will occur at milesposts 383-384 while rockfall mitigation and rock-sealing work is underway. Closures will be limited to 20-minute intervals.
