

# **ADOT's Nondiscrimination Notice to the Public**





# Project Background



# Project Purpose and Need

- Increase roadway capacity
  - Improve operational efficiency and relieve congestion
  - Address existing roadway deficiencies
  - Reconstruct traffic interchanges and bridges to address existing deficiencies, and
  - Implement components of regional transportation plan
- 

# Project Overview

- Begin at MP 248.0,  $\frac{3}{4}$  miles north of Ina Traffic Interchange (TI)
- End at MP 251.9,  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile north of Ruthrauff Interchange
- Reconstruct and widen nearly four miles of I-10
- Three lanes in each direction to four lanes
- Add auxiliary lanes to create two-lane entrance and exit ramps
- Remove existing inside shoulder pavement and construct additional lane in each direction near the Ina Road Interchange




# Project Overview

- Reconstruct Orange Grove Road Interchange
  - Provide adequate vertical clearance
- Reconstruct Sunset Road Interchange
  - Bring Sunset Road over I-10
  - Provide adequate vertical clearance
- Reconstruct the Cañada del Oro Wash and Rillito River bridges
- Construct retaining walls as needed
- Provide drainage, lighting, landscaping and other improvements



# Construction Phasing

- Existing I-10 traffic will be moved to Frontage Roads
  - Access to all businesses will be retained
  - Orange Grove Road will be restricted
  - Sunset Road will be closed from Silverbell Road to I-10


# Construction Phasing

- Phase A
- Mainline traffic on the frontage roads
- Orange Grove Road will be restricted
- Sunset Road will be closed
  - from Silverbell Road to I-10
- Ina Road and Ruthrauff Road will remain open



# Construction Phasing

- Phase B
- Mainline traffic on newly constructed mainline
- Orange Grove Road will be reopened
- Sunset Road will continue to be closed
- Ina Road and Ruthrauff Road will remain open



# Bicycle/Pedestrian Access The Chuck Huckelberry Loop

- Minimal impact to use anticipated
- Short-term closures crossing the freeway during high-risk activities such as demolition and girder placement
- Overhead protection will be provided





- National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) of 1969
- Environmental Assessment (EA) was used to evaluate potential environmental impacts
- The purpose of the EA is to describe the need for a proposed action, alternatives evaluated (including the No Build Alternative), environmental impacts of those alternatives, and any necessary mitigation measures.
- Environmental topics:
  - *Air Quality*
  - *Cultural Resources*
  - *Hazardous Materials*
  - *Neighborhood and Community Considerations*
  - *Secondary and Cumulative Impacts*
  - *Water Resources*
  - *Biological Resources*
  - *Environmental Justice/Title VI*
  - *Land Use*
  - *Noise*
  - *Section 4(f) Resources*




