### **ADOT'S NONDISCRIMINATION NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC**

The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) hereby gives public notice that it is the Agency's policy to assure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA), and other related authorities in all of its programs and activities.

ADOT's Title VI and ADA Programs require that no person shall, on the grounds of race, color, national origin, or disability, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity.

Any person, who believes his/her Title VI or ADA rights have been violated, may file a complaint. Any such complaint must be in writing and filed with the ADOT Civil Rights Office within one hundred eighty (180) days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence. 

This project will upgrade 411 HPS (high pressure sodium) roadway lights to LED (light emitting diode) in the southern region. Currently, 411 of our rural roadway lights are HPS. LED lighting uses less energy, requires less maintenance, and has a longer life expectancy than HPS lighting. All rural roadway lighting will be 100pct LED in the southern traffic and lighting region upon completion of this project. The plan is to have the work completed before the end of FY22. The luminaires will be purchased through Procurement and ADOT personnel will install them. ICAP is included in this request.




