



State Route 99: Canyon Diablo Bridge Rehabilitation

BRIDGE REHABILITATION AND REPLACEMENT PROJECT

OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation in conjunction with the Federal Highway Administration is planning a bridge rehabilitation project on State Route 99 between mileposts 71 and 72 south of the community of Leupp, Coconino County at a cost of \$744,630. The project is needed to protect the pier foundations from failure due to erosion by installing erosion counter measures.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Construction is scheduled to begin spring 2022 and final project completion is anticipated fall 2022. While paving work is underway, motorists will encounter daytime lane restrictions. Throughout the paving work, a minimum of one lane of traffic will be maintained. Additional temporary advance warning signs will be embedded two miles south of the project limits on State Route 99 and east- and westbound along Indian Route 15/Leupp Road. ADOT advises drivers to plan for possible delays while the work is underway.
