

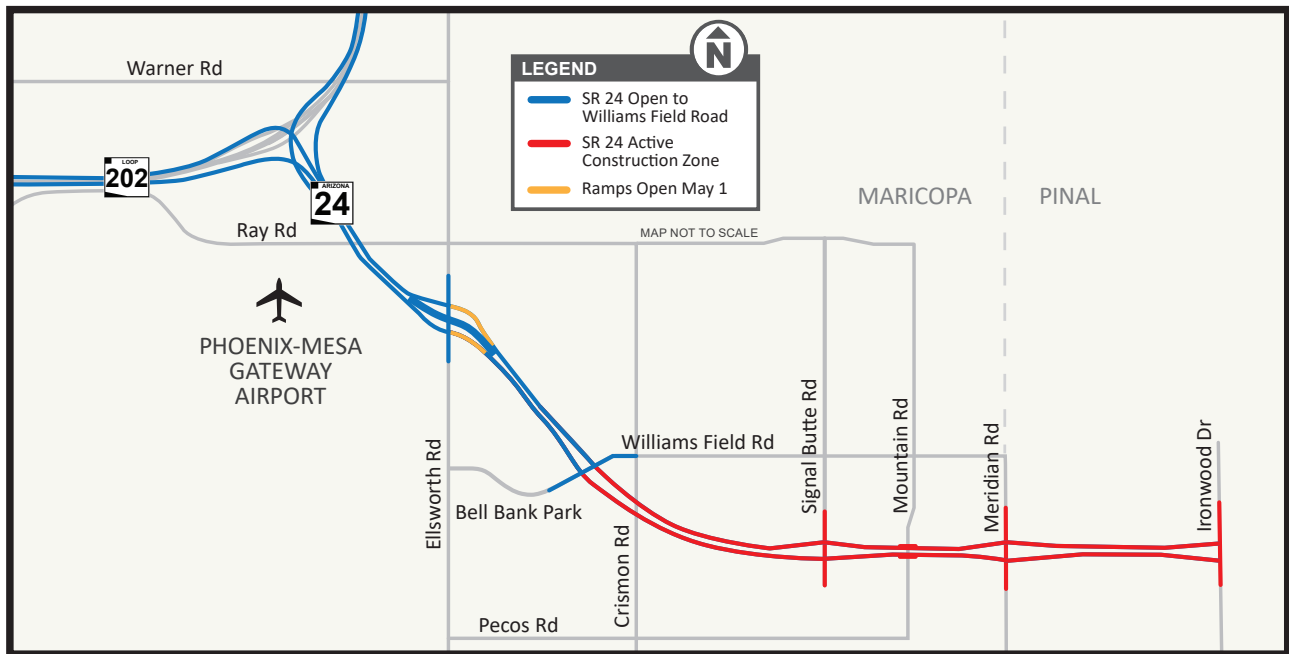

## State Route 24 Interim Phase II: Ellsworth Road to Ironwood Drive Construction Notice

INTERIM OPENING BETWEEN ELLSWORTH AND WILLIAMS FIELD ROADS

### OVERVIEW

Beginning April 1, east- and westbound SR 24 will be open between Ellsworth and Williams Field roads for local access only. Drivers may access Bell Bank Park or the Cadence community using SR 24 to the new Williams Field Road exit. Drivers wanting to travel further east should continue to use alternate routes. The one-mile-long extension of SR 24 as a divided four-lane road is being opened early in partnership with the city of Mesa.



### ABOUT THE PROJECT

Phase II of SR 24 includes approximately five miles of new roadway extending from Ellsworth Road to Ironwood Drive. The new roadway includes two lanes in each direction separated by a median; at-grade intersections at Williams Field Road, Signal Butte Road, Meridian Road and Ironwood Drive; and bridges over Ellsworth and Mountain roads. Project construction is expected to be complete late summer 2022.
