
## OVERVIEW

ARIZONA

The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) advises drivers that crews are scheduled to begin constructing new Loop 303 traffic interchanges at 51st and 43rd avenues in September. Construction will mostly occur outside the existing roadway. However, drivers can expect periodic restrictions and closures on Loop 303 during construction, which is expected to be completed in fall 2023.



## **ABOUT THE PROJECT**

The Arizona Department of Transportation, in coordination with the Maricopa Association of Governments, the Federal Highway Administration and the city of Phoenix, is constructing new Loop 303 traffic interchanges at 51st and 43rd avenues to address expected traffic growth prompted by current and planned development in the area. In addition to the new traffic interchanges, the project also will include:

- Constructing new bridges on Loop 303 over 51st and 43rd avenues
- Extending the southbound Loop 303 frontage road from 43rd to 51st avenues
- The 51st Avenue interchange will be shifted slightly to the west to accommodate the realignment of 51st Avenue
- The list of improvements also includes drainage upgrades, and new signals, signs, pavement markings and lights.
