



I-10, SR 85 to Verrado Way Construction Notice

GENERAL PROJECT INFORMATION

Reconstruction of I-10/SR 85 ramps will require closures mid-September until mid-October:

The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) advises drivers to plan for upcoming closures at the Interstate 10/State Route 85 system interchange ramps as part of the I-10, SR 85 to Verrado Way widening project. The ramps will be closed in two phases from Sept. 11 through mid-October.

PHASE 1: Sept. 11-29. The following ramps will be CLOSED:

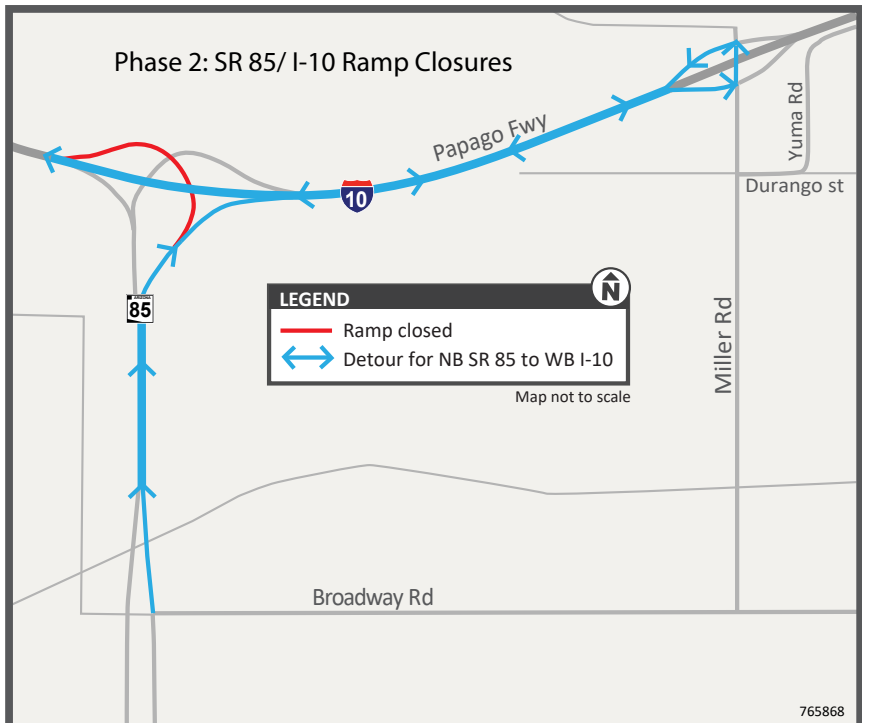
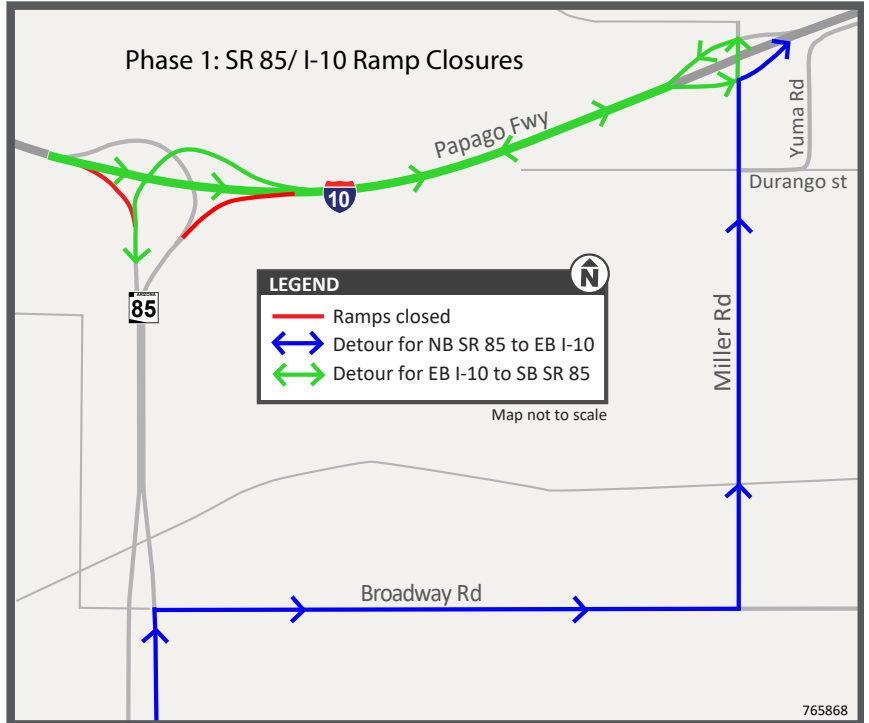
- ▶ Eastbound I-10 to southbound SR 85 ramp. Detour: Drivers on eastbound I-10 may exit at Miller Road and use westbound I-10 to access the SR 85 southbound ramp.
- ▶ Northbound SR 85 to eastbound I-10 ramp. Detour: Drivers on northbound SR 85 may exit at Broadway Road and use eastbound Broadway Road to Miller Road, then north to access eastbound I-10.

PHASE 2: To be announced. The following ramp will be CLOSED:

- ▶ Northbound SR 85 to westbound I-10 ramp. Detour: Drivers on northbound SR 85 may use the ramp to eastbound I-10, exit at Miller Road and enter westbound I-10.
