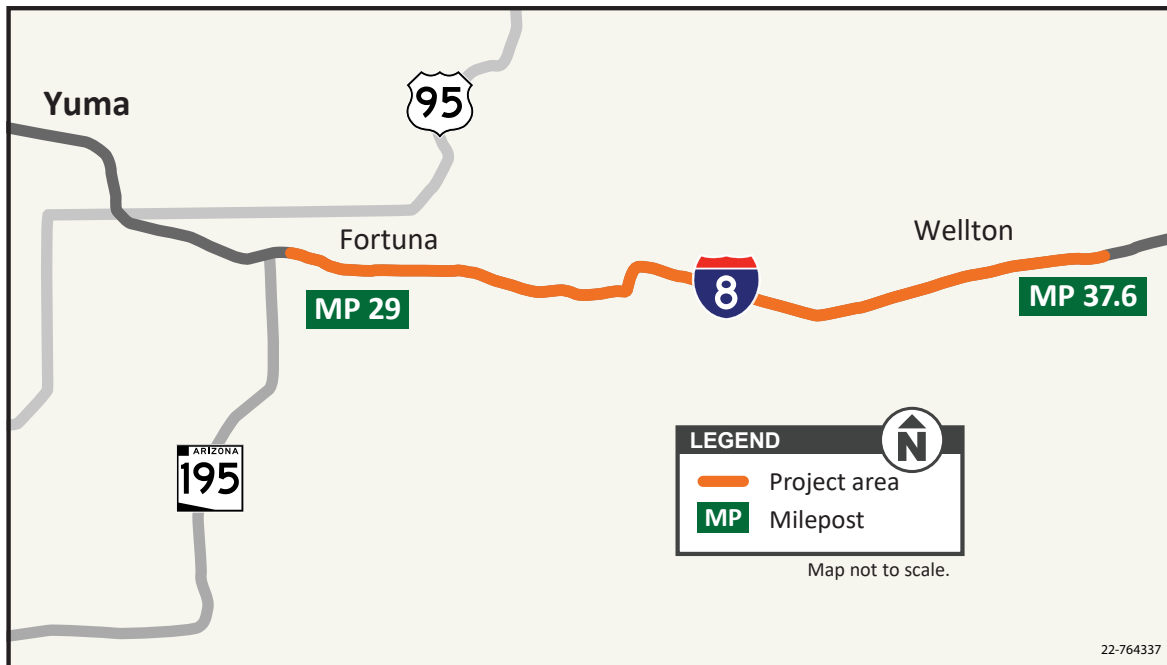




Interstate 8, Wellton to Avenue 36E

PAVEMENT LIFE EXTENSION



OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation is repairing the pavement on Interstate 8 between milepost 29 (near Wellton) and Avenue 36E (milepost 37.6) in Yuma County. The work consists of removing and replacing the existing pavement.

Additional road work will also include spot repair work with new asphalt concrete, replacing pavement markings and other miscellaneous work.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Construction is scheduled to begin late winter 2022 with completion anticipated late spring 2023.

Expect delays as lane restrictions on Interstate 8 will be necessary. Work is scheduled to occur between 6 a.m. and 5 p.m. Mondays through Fridays.
