# **Blowout Wash Bridge Rehabilitation, Cottonwood**

## **ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE**



### **OVERVIEW**

The Arizona Department of Transportation is administering a federal project for the city of Cottonwood that will rehabilitate a bridge on Pima Street between Second Street and Third Street. The work consists of replacing the existing bridge deck and railing, reconstructing the roadway approaches and other related work. The purpose of the project is to extend the life of the bridge.

The project is scheduled to begin in November 2022 and be completed in early 2023.

#### WHAT TO EXPECT

Pima Street, between Second and Third streets, will be closed to all traffic during construction.

The closure will necessitate a short detour east of the Old Town Cottonwood business district. The detour will enable residents living on Third, Fourth and Fifth streets to travel south to Main Street in order to access Pima Street west of the bridge closure.
